SPRING WILDLIFE SAFARI: UNIQUE SKY ISLANDS BIODIVERSITY

Visit a magical forested mountain range isolated by intervening valleys of grassland and desert. Situated at the meeting of the Sonoran & Chihuahuan Deserts and two continental mountain ranges, -the Sierra Madre & Rocky Mountains - the Sky Islands host some of the most diverse Ecosystems in the world! The great topographic complexity, strategic location of these mountain ranges, and unique climatic influences support many perennial streams, a high number of endemic species, and a bewildering wildlife diversity. The Sky Islands harbor more than half of the bird species of North America, 29 bat species, more than 75 reptile species, and 104 species of mammals, -an overall diversity greater than anywhere else in the United States.
