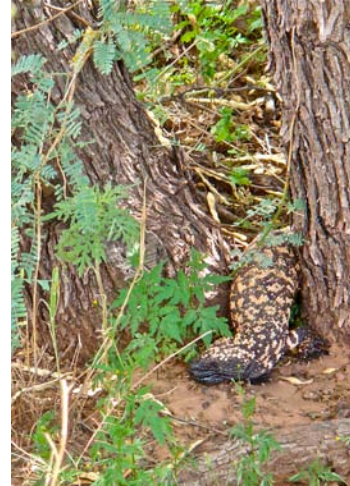


RAVENS-WAY WILD JOURNEYS

Situated at the meeting of the Sonoran & Chihuahuan Deserts and the Sierra Madre & Rocky Mountains, the Sky Islands Region is one of the most diverse Ecosystems in the world! The great topographic complexity, unique location at the meeting point of several major desert and forest regions, and the blend of tropical and temperate climates, leads to a diversity greater than anywhere else in the United States! The Sky Islands host well over half the bird species of North America, 29 bat species, & 104 species of mammals! In Spring you have a wonderful opportunity to see a wide range of bird species, as well as Collared Peccaries, Coatis, Mountain Lion, & a number of other fascinating Wildlife!
