Few places in the Southwest can compare to the solitude, beauty, & pristine recesses of spectacular Aravaipa Canyon. This remote Wilderness beckons the curious Naturalist with over 200 species of birds, desert bighorn sheep, coatis, ringtail cats, foxes, black bear, raccoon, and 7 species of Native fish! The perennial waters of Aravaipa Creek have carved a scenic canyon through the Sonoran desert at the northern end of the Galiuro Mountains. February is a wonderful time to explore this sublime stronghold of Nature with Ethnobotanist, Naturalist & Wildlife Biologist Vincent Pinto as your guide into the Wilderness!
