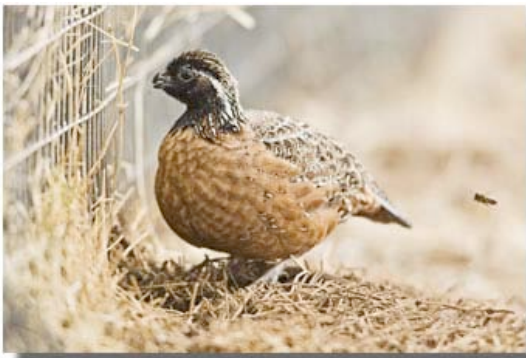


# RAVENS-WAY WILD JOURNEYS

As one of the largest wild areas in southern Arizona, Buenos Aires NWR provides 118,000 acres of habitat for threatened and endangered plants and animals. The semidesert grassland supports the reintroduction of masked bobwhite quail and pronghorns! A wide diversity of habitats & a corresponding high level of biodiversity allows for wandering amidst 325 bird species, 53 species of reptiles and amphibians, and 58 mammal species!
