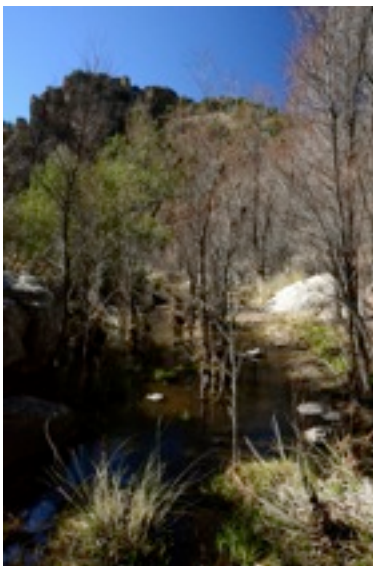


RAVENS-WAY WILD JOURNEYS

Over 625 species of plants have been identified, many of which are rare and/or endangered. Sycamore Canyon's animal life is extremely diverse as well, especially its birds, - with over 130 species!
